

**LOUGHBOROUGH TOWN NETBALL LEAGUE**  
**REGISTRATION – GUIDELINES 2023-24**



TO: CLUB SECRETARY

Please complete the attached registration form for your Club and return by preferably 2nd September 2023 but by the 9<sup>th</sup> September 2023 at the latest.

**THE FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS APPLY TO ALL REGISTRATIONS:**

- A registration form **MUST** be completed by each Club at the start of the season with all the player details (no form – no registration!)
- During the season, forms are downloadable from the website, will also be in the match folder on the desk
- Junior players - All 14 or 15 year old requesting to play in the LTNL must complete the “Application to play in the Leicestershire Adult League” form on the Leicestershire website <https://form.jotform.com/231622532892052> (please note any player under 14 cannot be registered). A parental form must also be completed for any player under 18.
- Registration Forms should be forwarded to Debbie via email only. (All details are held securely and will be used by LTNL committee for the purpose of participation in Netball and to provide players information about Netball. All forms are destroyed at the end of each season.)
- Money should be paid upon return of the form, via bank transfer (see details below) If payment is not paid when the new player plays – the player is **NOT REGISTERED**, and appropriate points deduction/fines will be imposed.

**Player registration fees:** £1 per player (including Under 18)

**Re-registration fee:** £1 (this applies if re-registering a player up from a lower team or moving to another club within the LTNL)

Match Fees will be £28

England Netball fees are £48.80 (payable via Engage)

**ADDITIONAL RULES:**

Any new registrations **MUST** be received **7 days** prior to a player playing and include the EN affiliation number.

A player can re-register from one team to another team within the same club as long as written instruction is received giving a minimum of **4 days'** notice.

The LTNL will continue to follow the Regional League ruling for the 2023-24 season as follows:  
A Player cannot play in the LTNL if they have played more than 16 quarters in the National League.  
In addition, any player in a Superleague team squad, cannot play in the LTNL (Checks will be made with the Regional League to monitor this).

## ENGLAND NETBALL REGISTRATION

All players (and Umpires) should be registered with England Netball. **LTNL REQUIRE THE 'ENGLAND NETBALL' INDIVIDUAL AFFILIATION MEMBERSHIP NUMBER** on the Registration form.

Please Note: England Netball run an insurance scheme which is linked to the affiliation; therefore ALL players MUST be registered so players are covered for civil liability and personal accident insurance.

England Netball fees are available from their website. [www.englandnetball.co.uk](http://www.englandnetball.co.uk)

The LTNL do not accept any responsibility for players or clubs not fully affiliated through England Netball, which may affect their insurance cover.

*It is the club's responsibility to make sure players are registered with England Netball.*

### LTNL JUNIOR PLAYER RULES

1. The minimum age to play in the LTNL adult league is 14 years old. A Young Person Application form or player registration will NOT be accepted if under 14.
2. A player age 14 or 15 is NOT eligible to play in the LTNL until the Club and League receives the confirmation email from the LCNA Vice Chair.
3. Age 14 or 15 year olds are only permitted to play in the Division assessed for (or division below). They are unable to play up for a team playing in a higher Division (this included the Cup/Plate Competition). i.e no lives up a division and no re-registration up (unless a new form is completed and they are re-assessed).
4. Players at age 14 years are not eligible to play in the LTNL Premier Division. They are eligible to play in Divisions 1,2,3 dependent on the Division they are assessed for. Age 15 years can only play in the Premier Division if assessed to play in that Division.
5. There is a maximum limit of 3 x aged 14 and/or age 15 players on court at any one time\*.
6. Any team playing an age 14 player - the Captain should be minimum age 18 and participate in the game (minimum of 1 x quarter played).
7. Any team playing age 15 and over - the captain MUST be age 16 or over. In addition, there must be a Safeguarding person/Manager on the bench who is the responsible adult (age 18 or over) who makes themselves known to the Umpires.

\* There will be an exception to this ruling in the case of injury etc. if the only reserve on the bench is age 14 or 15, an additional age 14 or 15 player will be allowed on court. This will be noted on the team sheet.
